Privacy Policy

The British Columbia Disc Golf Association (BCDGA) takes privacy, security, and data protection seriously. We are committed to securing and protecting all personal information in our control to ensure it will be used appropriately.

1. Purpose

The Purpose of the BCDGA Privacy Policy is to inform users that we collect, use and disclose personal information from members and other individuals as necessary to fulfill the following purposes that include, but are not limited to:

- Registration
- Communications
- Sales, promotions and merchandising
- Travel arrangement and administration
- Medical emergency contacts and emergency reports

2. Consent

By using this website, or otherwise providing your personal information to us, you consent to the processing of your personal information as set out in this policy. If you don't agree, please do not use our website. Further notices may be provided to you from time to time if we collect personal information directly from you.

3. Personal Data We Collect

We only collect data that helps us achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Gender
- Birthdate
- Phone number
- Address, Province, State, Postal code, City, Country

Our website may provide hyperlinks to other websites/programs that may be of interest to you. BCDGA and its representatives are not responsible for the content or privacy policies of those websites, and we urge you to review the privacy policies of those sites to determine how your information may be acquired or used.

Personal information may be shared with third-party service providers, government authorities, or other entities to fulfil the purposes described, as required by law, or to support our organizational operations. Any such sharing will be conducted in compliance with applicable data protection laws.

4. Security of Data

The protection of your data is very important to BCDGA. We take reasonable security measures to ensure that your personal information is not compromised.

We also emphasize that the internet itself is not a secure method of communication, therefore, we cannot guarantee that the privacy or absolute security of personal information submitted over the internet will not be compromised. No security safeguard can protect against every circumstance.

5. Cookie Policy

A cookie is a text file provided by a web server and stored by your browser. The contents of this file are then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. BCDGA uses cookies to provide the core user experience of the Website, including authenticated user sessions. Cookies are also used to provide BCDGA with statistical information related to the general use of our Website and email campaigns. 6. Safety Measures

BCDGA employs a range of measures to safeguard your personal information. This includes using technological, physical, and administrative processes to prevent unauthorized access, collection, disclosure, copying, use, modification, or disposal of personal data.

While we have implemented security protocols, it's important to recognize that the Internet inherently carries some risk when transmitting information. Therefore, we advise you to exercise caution and thoughtfulness in deciding what information you share with us and avoid sharing sensitive information where possible.

Additionally, you hold the responsibility of protecting your user identifications, passwords, or any other unique identifiers that grant access to our online services. By taking these precautions, you can further enhance the security of your personal data and interactions with BCDGA.
